Master of Science in Interdisciplinary Design and Management [MSc(IDM)]

1. MSc(IDM) is an executive Master programme, providing an unique opportunity for experienced real estate, design and construction professionals to improve personal and team performance through part-time study. Offering a highly specialised course leading to a MSc degree, MSc(IDM) consists chiefly of interactive workshops and seminars in which students can apply their own knowledge and experience whilst developing a deeper understanding of how improved collaboration can help define long-term business strategies. The programme attracts the highest calibre candidates from several disciplines, capitalising on their own strong achievements and diverse experiences to foster a new generation of leadership. MSc(IDM) is offered by the Faculty of Architecture with teaching contributions by members of other faculties, by local industry experts and by internationally renowned visiting professionals.

- 3. To be eligible for admission to the curriculum leading to the Master of Science in Interdisciplinary Design and Management, a candidate
 - (a) shall comply with the General Regulations;
 - (b) shall hold a Bachelor degree in a relevant field of this University or from a comparable institution accepted for this purpose;
 - (c) shall produce proof of relevant work experience (normally a minimum of two years post-degree practical experience in design, procurement, construction, policy-making or management of buildings, projects or urban districts, or an approved related industry field), including curriculum vitae and at least one letter of reference from a relevant employer or other as determined by the Programme Director;
 - (d) shall be fluent in both spoken and written English; and
 - (e) shall satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.

- 5. The closing date for application (September 2014 intake) is 31 May 2014.
