Master of Science in Environmental Management [MSc(EnvMan)]

- 1) Applications are invited for admission in September 2025 to read for the degree of Master of Science in Environmental Management (MSc(EnvMan). To be eligible for admission to the programme, an applicant shall satisfy both the University Admission Requirements and the Programme Specific Requirements as listed below:
 - a) shall comply with the General Regulations;
 - b) shall hold a Bachelor's degree of this University or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose;
 - c) shall satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required;
 - d) for an applicant who is seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to high degrees as prescribed under General Regulation G2(b).

An application for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case-by-case basis.

- 2) A set of the Regulations and Syllabuses is available <u>here</u>.
- 3) The MSc(EnvMan) programme is an inter-faculty multi-disciplinary coursework programme. It provides a comprehensive training in the field of environmental management, addressing both the major environmental problems and their social, legal and economic context.
- 4) The duration of the MSc(EnvMan) programme is one academic year of full-time study, or two academic years of part-time study.
- 5) Applications for the MSc(EnvMan) programme must be submitted via the <u>HKU TPg online application system</u> by <u>12:00 noon (GMT +8), April 30, 2025</u>, for both full-time and part-time studies.
- 6) Non-local students are advised to apply as early as possible to ensure completing all entry visa requirements prior to the commencement of the programme in September every year. In some cases, it may take up to three months to process the entry visa.
- 7) All applicants for the MSc(EnvMan) programme must provide at least one referee in the online application system. The University will send email invitations to the

- referee(s) for completing an online reference form via a designated online platform within four weeks from the date of successful submission of the application.
- Applications will be considered immediately until all places are filled. The results of the admissions exercise are expected to be announced as soon as possible but no later than late July 2025. Applicants may contact School of Biological Sciences (biotpg@hku.hk) if they do not receive any notification of their application results in early September.
- 9) The programme has been accredited by the <u>Institute of Environmental Management</u> and <u>Assessment (IEMA)</u>. Students completing specific courses of the programme are eligible to apply to be GradIEMA members.
- Starting from the Academic Year 2020-21, ENVM8020 *Green Building and Energy Management* has been accredited by Hong Kong Green Building Council Limited (HKGBC) and BEAM Society Limited (BSL). Students upon passing the examination of the course and completing the MSc(EnvMan) programme will be eligible to register as a BEAM Affiliate at HKGBC.
