Admission Information for Master of Governance and Policy (MGP)

1. Applications are invited for admission in September 2026 to programme leading to Master of Governance and Policy. To be eligible for admission to MGP, candidates:
 - (a) shall comply with the [General Regulations](#);
 - (b) shall hold
 - (i) a Bachelor's degree of this University; or
 - (ii) another qualification of equivalent standard from this University or from another University or comparable institution accepted for this purpose;
 - (c) who are seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to higher degrees as prescribed under [General Regulation G2\(b\)](#);
 - (d) preferably have a minimum of three years of professional working experience; and
 - (e) shall satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.

An application for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case-by-case basis.

2. The curriculum shall extend over not less than one and not more than two academic years of full-time study.
3. Applications for taught postgraduate admissions and payment of the non-refundable application fee (HK\$600 per application) should be submitted online at <https://portal.hku.hk/tpg-admissions>.
4. Applications are considered on a rolling basis. The earlier you submit your application, the earlier you will be notified of the admission decision. The application deadline is 12:00 noon on May 29, 2026.
