To facilitate your application, you are required to provide the official copies of your academic qualifications through the specified formats as set out below.

1. Complete/the latest official transcript(s) & Graduation Certificate(s)

- e-Transcript accessible via an official online platform of OR authorised by the awarding institution (e.g., Parchment, National Student Clearinghouse, [Academic Certificate Verification Platform](#) etc.),

[Overseas Institutes (Mainland Applicants)]

- Overseas Credentials Evaluation Report (教育部國外學歷學位認證書) of your overseas qualifications issued by the [Chinese Service Center for Scholarly Exchange \(CSCSE\)](#) [[中國留學網](#)] [Chinese version only].
- e-Transcript accessible via an official online platform of OR authorised by the awarding institution.

[Institutes in Mainland] (validity period should be 6 months or the longest available)

- online Verification Report of [China Higher Education Student's Academic Transcript](#) containing complete record of the years and examination results (中國高等學校學生成績驗證報告) (English & Chinese version).
- online Verification Report of Higher Education Qualification Certificate (教育部學歷證書電子注冊備案表) (English & Chinese version) issued by the [China Higher Education Student Information \(CHSI\)](#) [中國高等教育學生信息網](#).
- online Verification Report of Higher Education Degree Certificate (中國高等教育學位在線驗證報告) (English & Chinese version) issued by [China Higher Education Student Information \(CHSI\)](#) [中國高等教育學生信息網](#).

2. TOEFL/IELTS official score report (if applicable)

- For applicants from universities or comparable institutions outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English. (The University's TOEFL code is 9671.)
- Must be taken within 2 years prior to 1 September 2026

REMARKS

- 1) All e-documents are to be sent to the following email address: psymed@hku.hk.
- 2) Applicants are strongly advised to submit their applications directly to the University and avoid the involvement of any intermediary agencies. Any misrepresentation will disqualify application(s) to the University and the University has the right to make a report to the relevant law enforcement agencies which may result in criminal prosecution.
- 3) Notarized copies or certified true documents issued by the awarding universities will NOT be accepted.
- 4) Transcripts, diplomas, certificates and other submitted documents which are not in English should be accompanied by a certified translation in English.
- 5) The processing time of student visa applications is approximately 10-12 weeks. It is the responsibility of individual students to make appropriate visa arrangement before they come to Hong Kong. Please click [here](#) for mainland students / [here](#) for foreign students for further details.
- 6) Submitted documents are non-returnable and will be securely destroyed in the event of an unsuccessful application.
