**Master of Social Sciences in the field of
Media, Culture and Creative Cities**

1. Applications are invited for admission in September 2026 to the programme leading to the degree of Master of Social Sciences in the field of Media, Culture and Creative Cities. To be eligible for admission to the programme, a candidate shall satisfy both the University admission requirements and the programme specific requirements as listed below:

- (a) shall comply with the [General Regulations](#) and the [Regulations for Taught Postgraduate Curricula](#);
- (b) shall hold a Bachelor's degree of this University, or another qualification of equivalent standard from this University or from another University or comparable institution accepted for this purpose;
- (c) shall preferably have working experience in the media and cultural sector;
- (d) for a candidate who is seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is *not* English, shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to higher degrees as prescribed under General Regulation G2(b)*; and
- (e) shall satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.

An application for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case-by-case basis.

2. The curriculum shall extend over not less than one and not more than two academic years of full-time study, or not less than two and not more than four academic years of part-time study.
3. Applications for this taught postgraduate programme and payment of application fee should be made through the HKU on-line application system at <http://www.hku.hk/tpg>.
4. The closing date for application is **12:00 noon (GMT+8), November 14, 2025 (Main round) and 12:00 noon (GMT+8), January 30, 2026 (Clearing round)**.

6. All applications will be reviewed by our panel, and the shortlisted candidates will receive an update and/or invitation to interview within one month, after the application deadline.
