

Master of Expressive Arts Therapy

1. Applications are invited for admission in September 2025 to the programme leading to the degree of Master of Expressive Arts Therapy by full-time study or by part-time study. The application deadline is:

12:00 noon (GMT +8), February 3, 2025

Admission Requirements

2. To be eligible for admission to the programme, a candidate shall satisfy both the University admission requirements and the programme specific requirements as listed below:
 - (a) shall comply with the [General Regulations](#) and the Regulations for Taught Postgraduate Curricula;
 - (b) shall hold a Bachelor's degree of this University, preferably in a field related to social sciences, healthcare, education or the arts disciplines; or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose;
 - (c) for a candidate who is seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, shall satisfy the following University English language requirement applicable to higher degrees as prescribed under [General Regulation G2\(b\)](#);
 - (d) shall preferably have had a minimum of three years of post-qualification experience in the relevant fields;
 - (e) shall submit an arts portfolio to demonstrate proficiency in using at least one arts form (visual art, music, dance, drama, poetry); and
 - (f) shall satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.

An application for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Application

3. Applications for this taught postgraduate programme and payment of application fee (HK\$300 per application) should be made through the HKU on-line application system at <https://admissions.hku.hk/tpg/>. Upon successful payment, applicants will receive a unique application number.
4. After submitting the online application, applicants are required to submit an arts portfolio and post the supporting documents to the Centre on Behavioral Health (2/F, 5 Sassoon Road, Pokfulam, Hong Kong) **by the deadline of online application**. 5. Applicants must obtain the Bachelor's degree on or before August 31, 2025 to apply for admission.
