**Master of Science in Implant Dentistry**

Applications are invited for admission in September 2026 to read for the degree of Master of Science in Implant Dentistry (two-year full-time). To be eligible for admission to the curriculum, a candidate shall:

- (a) comply with the General Regulations and the Regulations for Taught Postgraduate Curricula;
- (b) hold the degree of Bachelor of Dental Surgery from this University, or a degree or other qualification of equivalent standard from another university or comparable institution accepted for this purpose;
- (c) for a candidate who is seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to higher degrees as prescribed under General Regulation G2(b); and
- (d) satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.

Applications for a taught postgraduate programme can be submitted via our on-line application system at <https://portal.hku.hk/tpg-admissions/>. The application fee is HK\$600 per application (non-refundable and non-transferable), paid by credit card online.

The closing date for applications is **12:00 noon (HKT), March 31, 2026**.  
[Note: Late applications may still be considered at the discretion of the Postgraduate Programme Director.]
