**Application for Admission to the
Master of Nursing**

Applications are invited for admission in September 2026 to the Master of Nursing (MNurs) Programme.

The MNurs Programme aims to prepare registered nurses for advanced and specialised nursing practice. It offers a full-time study mode of one academic year (three semesters) and a part-time study mode of two academic years (six semesters).

Candidates are required to complete 2 core courses, 1 concentration course, 3 specialty courses, 3 elective courses and a capstone experience which includes a Translational Nursing Research course and a Dissertation or Clinical Research Project.

To be eligible for admission to the Programme, a candidate shall satisfy both the University Admission Requirements and the Programme Specific Requirements as listed below:

- (a) comply with the [General Regulations](#);
- (b) comply with the Regulations for [Taught Postgraduate Curricula](#);
- (c) be a Registered Nurse holding a Bachelor's degree in nursing from this University, or from another university, or a comparable institution accepted for this purpose; and
- (d) satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.

An application for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case-by-case basis.

2nd round: 12:00 noon (GMT+8), March 20, 2026

Applicants may be required to attend an interview and/or sit for a test arranged by the School as part of the selection process. Results will be announced around ten to twelve weeks after the respective application deadlines by email.
